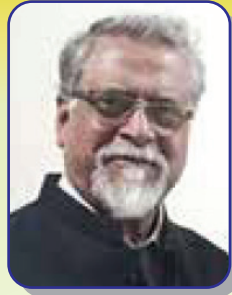

General Guideline for Presentation

Abstract Submission: (Free Paper / Award Paper etc.)

The scientific committee invites all delegates to submit their abstracts for original work for oral, video presentation at the "Aesthetica Asia 2024".

Please Note

- Last date of abstract submission is 6th November 2024.
- It is mandatory for presenting authors to register for the conference
- Please mail your abstracts at "info@aestheticaasia.in, rn_dutta@rediffmail.com
- Strict adherence to be kept with the submission guidelines

Guidelines for Abstract Submission:

- Word limit of the abstract is 250 words (excluding title, authors, their affiliations etc.)
- Title should be brief and self-explanatory
- The abstract should be original and unpublished till date.
- Avoid using keywords, graphs, figures, tables or references in abstract.
- Conflict of interest statement and declaration of conflict is mandatory.
- The onus of ensuring proper language, factual accuracy & responsibility of avoiding plagiarism lies with the authors.
- On acceptance of the abstract the acknowledgment will be sent.
- The abstract should be submitted only after registering for the conference.
- PGTs can attach a certificate from their respective HOD (for award session).

Award Paper Session

Award Paper Session is for the PGT's and young dermatologist upto the age of 35 years. The presentation will be for 8 minutes and following a 2 minutes Question Answer Session. The best 3 presenters will be awarded. And all the presenters will receive a certificate of presentation.

All PGT's should submit a certificate from their respective HODs.

Young dermatologist should submit their age proof (Aadhar, Driving Licences, any other).

HISTORY : Hyderabad is the capital of southern India's Telangana state. A major center for the technology industry, it's home to many upscale restaurants and shops. Its historic sites include Golconda Fort, a former diamond-trading center that was once the Qutb Shahi dynastic capital. The Charminar, a 16th-century mosque whose 4 arches support towering minarets, is an old city landmark near the long-standing Laad Bazaar.

TOURIST PLACES TO VISIT IN HYDERABAD

Charminar : Charminar stands tall in the heart of the city since 1591. It was built by Mohammed Quli Qutub Shah reflecting Cazia style. Charminar's unique architecture and detailed design with four 48.7 meter high minarets used to warn the king's men, is something to marvel at! It is one of the most famous places to visit in Hyderabad. With Mecca Masjid, Bhagyalakshmi Temple Laad Bazaar and Meena Bazaar right beside the monument, you can witness the vividness of this city here. If you love history and street shopping, Charminar is a must-visit place in Hyderabad for you!

Golconda Fort : Predating the Charminar, built by the Kakatiyas Dynasty in the 13th century, Golkonda witnessed reigns of many dynasties over the history—from Bahmani, Qutub Shahis, to even Mugal regimes. Constructed on a granite hill, the citadel is a true reflection of ancient architecture and engineering. The most appealing feature of the monument is it's acoustic: The monument resonates sounds through the wall right from the entrance, Fateh Darwaza, to the highest point, Bala Hissar. Golkonda is one of the best places to visit in Hyderabad. Witness the rich and instructive history lively resting in the rocks of the monument.

Makkah Masjid : Makkah Masjid is one of the oldest and largest mosques in India. Located close to landmarks of Charminar, Laad Bazaar and Chowmahalla Palace, the mosque holds 400-year-old history in its bricks. The mosque gets its name from Macca, the holiest site for Muslims: The monument was constructed from the soil brought in from Mecca upon the order of the late Muhammad Quli Qutb Shah, the fifth ruler of the Qutb Shahi dynasty. The three arched facades were carved from a single piece of granite and it took more than 8,000 workers to build the mosque.

Salarjung Museum : Home to some of the most stunning art collections and artifacts, Salarjung Museum- the legacy of the Salar Jung family is one of the famous places in Hyderabad. It was inaugurated on 16 December 1951 by the late prime minister, Jawaharlal Nehru. The antiquities in the museum were held private by the Salar Jung family before becoming public in 1951.

The museum showcases a variety of artworks, from Indian Art, Art of the Middle East, European Art, to even Far Eastern Art. Moreover, Indian sculptures, Persian carpets, bronze statues, Chinese porcelain, wood carvings and many more are some of the attractions in the museum.

Ramoji Film City : Ramoji Film City - one of the biggest of the largest film studio complex in the world, is one of the best places to visit in Hyderabad. Build by a Telugu film producer Ramoji Rao in the year 1996, it's the largest integrated film city in the state. It is home to a large range of gardens and sets that will keep you intrigued all day long! Not just that, this place also conducts several shows to let people see how it all works in films! If you want to observe the film industry up close, it is the best place for you.

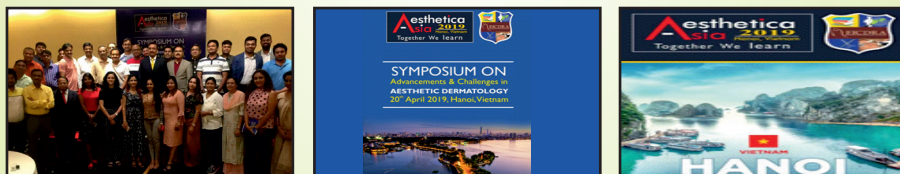
